FSA ID

- I FSA ID IS NEEDED FOR FAFSA EVERY YEAR, AND FOR EVERY YEAR OF LOAN REPAYMENT.
- FSA ID IS TIED TO YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER AND IS UNIQUE

FAFSA

- A STANDARD FORM THAT COLLECTS DEMOGRAPHIC AND FINANCIAL
- INFORMATION ABOUT THE STUDENT AND FAMILY
- I FILED ELECTRONICALLY AT FAFSA.GOV
- **I** APPLYING TAKES APPROXIMATELY 30 MINUTES
- I AVAILABLE OCTOBER 1ST FOR NEXT SCHOOL YEAR

FINANCIAL AID OFFICE

- **I** EACH STUDENT ASSIGNED FINANCIAL AID COUNSELOR BY LAST NAME

- I HELP WITH VERIFICATION AND APPEALS PROCESS

- I PRIVATE LOANS MAY BE NECESSARY
- THERE ARE LIMITS TO SCHOLARSHIPS, LOANS, GRANTS, ETC.
- **STAY CONNECTED WITH ADVISORS TO GRADUATE**
- I APPLY FOR FAFSA EVERY YEAR AND RENEW THOSE SCHOLARSHIPS

I NEXT STEP: SUBMIT FINANCIAL PAPERWORK NEEDED FOR THE I-20: *SUBMIT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IF YOU PLAN TO ATTEND THIS FALL; IF YOUR PLANS HAVE CHANGED, PLEASE LET ME KNOW.

- 1. CERTIFICATE OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CFR);
 - a. If awarded, list your Invitation to Idaho scholarship in the Sources of Funds table, in *UI Department* section on the CFR; include the total amount of the scholarship on the same line but in the right column that says, "Amount in U.S. Dollars."
 - b. Submit the CFR electronically to your **Application Status Portal**;

- 2. Bank statement; **Your bank statement will need to show that you have the funds to afford the balance of \$26,272.
 - a. Please ensure that the financial institution's name, the account holder's name, and account balance are all clearly visible.
 - b. **Please note that financial paperwork should not be dated prior to 6 months before the date that you will be issued your I-20; Spring 2022 I-20's will be issued this fall.
 - c. Submit a pdf copy of your bank statement electronically to your Application Status Portal;

- 3. Copy of passport: Biographical Page
- *Once you have received your I-20, pay the I-901 fee. **I-901 SEVIS fee payment registers you in the U.S. Immigration system; here is a video on how to make the payment: https://studyinthestates.dhs.gov/students/i-901-sevis-fee-payment-video

- **Once the I-901 fee is paid, print and save the receipt; now you can schedule a U.S. visa appointment at the nearest U.S. Embassy or consulate.
- Once You Have Been Issued Your I-20: Visit the Admitted International Student and continue making progress towards a Fall semester arrival:
