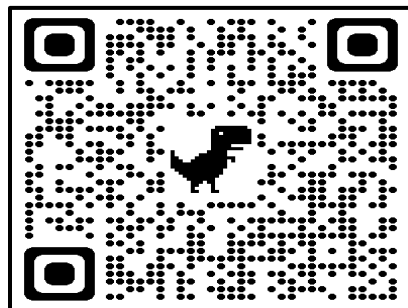

Applicants must be pursuing a science, technology, engineering or math degree; Applicants must have an overall minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale for merit-based scholarships. Applicants may have a minimum 2.5 GPA for non-merit-based donor scholarships; Applicants must be of Hispanic descent and/or must demonstrate significant leadership or service within the underserved community; Applicants may be enrolled full-time or part-time at the time of application and the time of the scholarship award; Applicants must be enrolled in a STEM or health-related undergraduate or graduate program for the upcoming fall semester, at an accredited 2-yr or 4-yr college/university in the U.S. or its territories</p> | <p>The College JumpStart Scholarship is an annual, merit-based competition -- financial need is not considered -- that is open to 10th-12th graders, college students and non-traditional students.
